

Footwear Regulations

Shoes should be plain black made from polished leather or patent and can be lace-up, velcro or slip on shoes in a traditional school style. Boots, blue shoes or shoes with a white or coloured soles are not permitted. Pupils will be required to replace shoes that do not meet these requirements.

Note:

The following **do not** conform to school regulations and **must not** be worn –

- Boots
- Blue shoes
- White or coloured soles
- Shoes made from suede, Nu-buck or canvas.
- Trainer type shoes e.g. converse.

Parents of pupils whose shoes do not conform with school regulations will be asked to purchase new shoes immediately. Please see below examples of styles of acceptable and unacceptable footwear. If in doubt, parents are advised to contact the school before purchasing shoes.
