Our School Day



The school day is divided into 9 periods. Lessons usually last for either one or two periods. A bell rings at the end of each period.

Different subjects are taught by different teachers. Usually classes move between classrooms so that you are taught in specialist rooms e.g. your Science lessons will be in a Science lab so that you will be able to do practical work.
